

Expression of Interest - Trauma Informed Approach Champions

Lakes DHB in conjunction with Werry Workforce Whāraurau have developed a pilot training program for Rotorua Lakes District schools to implement trauma-informed approaches (TIA).

The research that informs this training comes from Western (mainly US) and Indigenous research (US and NZ). It is our aim to develop an understanding of the impact of trauma for people in Aotearoa, particularly tangata whenua and how this shapes our understanding of working in a trauma-informed way. The training is divided into four sessions; Realise, Recognise, Respond and Resist Retraumatization.

Commitment Required from Champions selected:

Pilot workshop 19th, 20th July, 2021

Ongoing training and support over 1 year - dates and delivery format to be advised.

Successful candidates would be expected to commit to all training dates and ongoing support in order for the approach to be effectively implemented in Rotorua Lakes Schools.

We only have the capacity to train 25-30 TIA Champions in this pilot. Should we receive expressions of interest above this number the TIA project team would select from the applications based on the following:

- Number of students who would benefit and be impacted by a Trauma Informed Approach within a school, group of schools (i.e. an LSC who works across more than one school)
- Number of Teachers who would benefit from the implementation of a Trauma Informed Approach within a school, group of schools (i.e. Kahui Ako)
- Equity across each of the 3 Kahui Ako in the Rotorua Lakes District
